### Foam Based Stature Enhancer

The foam based stature enhancer is designed to aid those that are of a physical stature that they require additional height to compensate for sitting activities in theater's or sporting event's etc; where added height may be required for adequate viewing. Additionally a foam based stature enhancer could add to the experience when dining, either alone or with others.


Additionally the device needs to be transportable and easily adaptable for conversion from the compact transportable form to the usage form.

The foam based unit is described as follows:

- 1. A pad device using a commercially available foam based product that could be commercially available and similar or identical to a urethane foam. The foam base material is covered in a non breathable fabric.
- 2. The above pad device may be configured in 1 or more defined panels. Each of the panels is appropriately sized to be placed on a seat. In any contiguous, and/or connected format the panels may be stacked, thus raising the height of the finished unit by the "stacked" height of the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, or any additional panels. While the individual panels do not have to be contiguous by virtue of the fabric covering, the ease of use appears to be greater with connected panels.
- 3. The device also contains a valve. During compression of the foam, air is allowed to escape from the cellular structure of the foam. The closing of the valve assures air will not reenter the foam thus assuring the padding retains its' compressed nature. The compressed nature assures a minimal size of the unit during storage and transport.
- 4. If the sectionalized device is covered with one contiguous breathable fabric then only 1 valve is required to allow both the air to escape and acts as an intake for air to "inflate" the foam to its' natural state.

#### What is claimed is:

- A singular panel, generally sized to a standard seat dimension, that consists of a combination of a foam or foam like material covered with a non-breathable fabric, and used for the sole purpose of elevating the user. The foam / fabric combination includes a valve that allows air to escape thus minimizing the dimension of the foam in its' normal state.
- 2. A singular panel as in claim 1, that is in combination with additional panels, thus allowing for "stacking" of the panels, by folding the additional lengths to areas that are comparable in size to the area of the initial foam seat.
